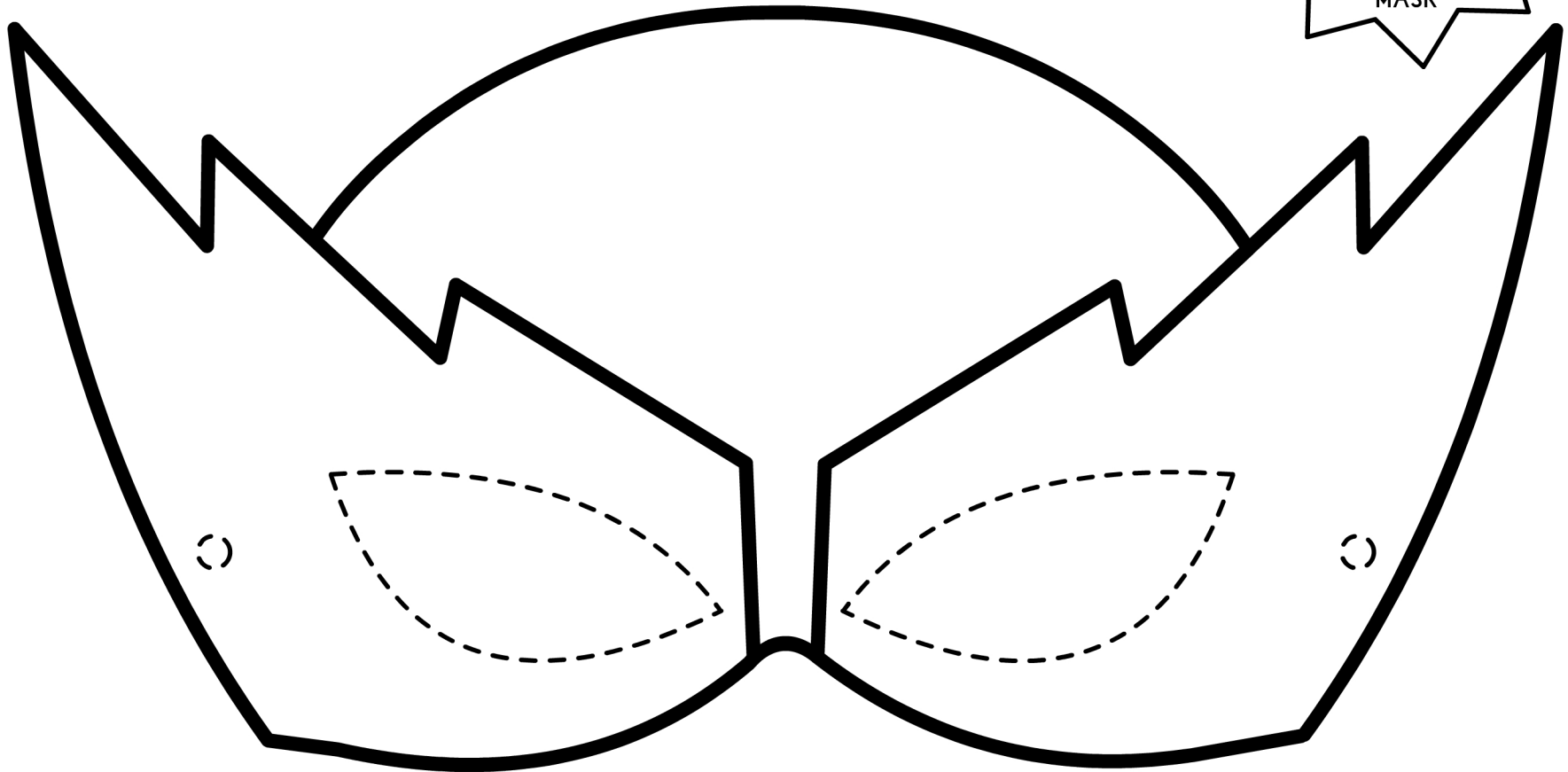
HISTORY
