Medieval illuminated manuscripts are some of the oldest picture books and they were often religious.

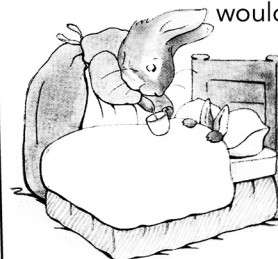


In 1744, John Newbery wrote the first children's book in English – **A Little Pretty Pocket-Book**.

In the mid-19th Century, famous fairy tales such as **Hansel and Gretel**, **Little Red Riding Hood**, and **The Little Mermaid** were being recorded by people like the Brothers Grimm and Hans Christian Andersen.



In 1902, Beatrix Potter's **The Tale of Peter Rabbit** was published and being what modern readers would recognize as a children's book.



Starting in 1937, **Dr. Seuss** began to publish books with whimsical art and poetry and would forever change what a children's picture book looked like.
